



Carolinan Ready Mixed Concrete Association 2023 Scholarship Information

To be eligible for scholarship, a student must meet the criteria below. These guidelines will apply in accepting applications for the CRMCA Scholarship fund:

1. **Length of Time:** Scholarships will be awarded for one year. Scholarships will not automatically renew, but students may reapply each year.
2. **Scholarship Number & Amount:** The CRMCA Board of Directors and the CRMCA Scholarship Committee will award up to \$5000.00 dollars in scholarships during the 2023 year. The number of scholarships may vary to meet total amount to be awarded.
3. **Eligibility & Type:** Scholarships will be awarded to students in their senior year of high school and/or attending a college or technical school. Both full and part time students are eligible. Two types of scholarships will be awarded:
 - a. **General Scholarship** awarded to students whose parents or guardians have been employed by a CRMCA member company domiciled in NC or SC for one or more years of continuous service.
 - b. **Construction Industry Scholarship** awarded to students residing in NC or SC and pursuing a degree in a construction related field of work.
4. **Timetable:** Scholarship applications will be accepted beginning with the spring semester each year. The scholarship winners will be notified by letter and announced each year in June. Scholarship recipients will be invited to attend a meeting of the Carolinas Ready Mixed Concrete Association to receive their scholarship. Deadline to submit for scholarship is May 31, 2023.
5. **Criteria:** Scholarships will be awarded based on merit as determined by the CRMCA Board of Directors and the CRMCA Scholarship Committee. Scholarships will be awarded to students attending a college, technical school or a senior in high school within North Carolina or South Carolina per the scholarship types above. 6. **Submission Requirements:** Only completed submissions will be reviewed. Any submission must include:
 - a. Completed Scholarship Application
 - b. Two letters of recommendation
 - c. For high school students: Please send a copy of your official high school transcripts. For college students (must have completed one full semester) please send your official college transcripts when submitting your application.

Scholarship Funds: Students must provide CRMCA with proof of school acceptance no later than July 31, 2023. After receiving proof of acceptance CRMCA will send check directly to school with scholarship recipient noted in the memo. Special instructions from school in regards to scholarship funds should be submitted to CRMCA with proof of acceptance.
